The By-laws Committee has 2 items for the Board:

1. Change in ZI Approved version for the Robert's Rules of Order

In December, ZI let us know that a newly revised version of Robert's Rules of Order was published in September 2011. The 11th edition of Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised will now be the version that will govern Zonta International. As stated in the ZI by-laws, the current version of Robert's Rules will apply.

Actions Recommended:

- 1. District 4 purchase an 11th Edition for the use of the District Board
- 2. Area Directors pass this information on to their Club Presidents.
- 3. Once the district has an 11th Edition, we check this version's definition for the use of "Chair vs. chairman", to prepare ourselves for commenting on the by-law change our district sent forward to ZI.

2. Review of the District 4 Rules of Procedure, Revised September 2008

The following 5 changes in the Rules of Procedure are recommended, to align with the Zonta International Bylaws:

Question: Do we keep a list of the descending order of votes (vs. total votes received) if a vacancy comes up?	Rules - Change Recommended: Add a new Procedure or modify District conference item 7 to state: A list will be kept that indicates the descending order of votes received for the Nominating Committee candidates, to facilitate the filling of a Nominating Committee vacancy if one arises during the 2 year term.

These Rules of Procedure may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the District Board.	District rules of procedure shall be adopted or amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the district conference voting members, provided that notice of such proposed rules of procedure

or amendments thereto shall be sent to the president of each club within the district at least sixty (60) days before the conference. Rules of procedure may be adopted or amended by a mail ballot. In that case, to take action, a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the delegates voting shall be required, provided more than fifty percent (50%) of the district clubs respond within forty-five (45) days."
Rules - Change Recommended: Align the D4 process with the ZI By-laws

Other Procedures to be Reviewed/confirmed

1) Rules of Procedure Item 2, pg 1

Current: The District will maintain a reserve fund of US\$5000.

Question: Is that still seen as an adequate reserve?

2) Rules of Procedure Nominating Committee Item 6, pg 4

Current: The Area Directors shall be elected at the District conference by the clubs in the area.

<u>Question:</u> Are the ballots currently divided by Area, to only show that Area's nominated Director?

3) Rules of Procedure Use of term "District Governor"

Current: Rule finances 1d refers to District governor (p 1) and Finances 2c refers to District Governor pin. There are other references to "district" in the title for Treasurer and Secretary. The ZI by-laws were changed to remove the "District" form the governor title.

<u>Question:</u> Can/should we make a blanket motion to remove the word "district" from the Officers titles?
