

Membership Report – November Board Meeting

As was discussed at our Retreat, a membership goal of 20 members (net) has been set as goal for our biennium.

During the past few months several clubs have had Membership Zings with plans for many more over the next few months. As result of these Zings there also has been an increase of a few members. A definite number is not available at this time.

There are concerns that in our District we also have many clubs under 20. The last report which was as of end of September, we had 11 clubs under 20 members with another 4 clubs with a membership of 10 or less.. This is worrisome and hopefully with further work over the biennium we can increase their membership numbers.

I am available to assist any clubs and am hoping that through Spring workshops or a Conference workshop we can provide some tangible ideas to all clubs. I will also send through Sandra Cronk some ideas on membership (recruitment, mentoring and retention) to Presidents which can be shared with membership chairpersons.

At present we have 938 members in the District.
