

Zonta District 4 Time Capsule 2019



District 4 will be burying a Time Capsule under the “Spirit of Womanhood” statue in Buffalo’s Delaware Park.



The Time Capsule, shown above, will be 14 inches long and 5 inches wide.

Each Club has been given an Archival Bag with their Club Name. There are 35 Zonta Clubs in District 4, so be cognizant of space. The Time Capsule and the Archival Bags will be displayed at the Centennial Conference in Buffalo, NY, Sept. 2019.

Items suggested for your “Archival Bag”:

- 1) A personal handwritten note from your club president or a member chosen by the Club. The note might contain information regarding successful fundraisers, service projects and monetary awards
- 2) Pictures of current membership, officer’s inductions, perhaps pictures of the first chartered members of your club.
- 3) A “USB” stick or a “Thumb drive” may be OK, depending on the technology in the future.
- 4) No – discs or CD – they might not be relevant in the future.
- 5) NOTHING BULKY
